This prestigious club will be the first club to be opened in India. The club will offer elegant surroundings with the opulence of a world class club surrounded by exclusive cricket memorabilia. The facility will also have a cricket academy and would partner with MCC to provide state of the art coaching facilities. The Academies will also provide health and fitness rooms for

exercise and training, changing rooms and relaxation facilities such as steam rooms and sauna .

Anglo Indian has plans for setting up 12 such clubs across the country.



ILC managed Club Opal now open!!

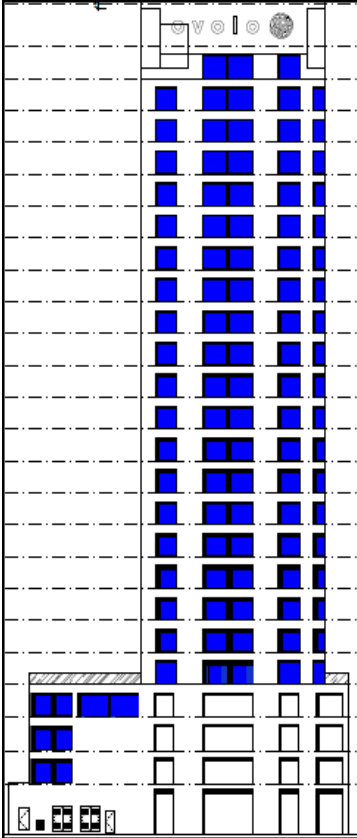
ILC has recently signed the management contract for the 35000 square foot 'Club Opal' which has been developed by the Olympia group as a part of its 'Olympia Opaline' development in the OMR in Chennai.

In the first stage of opening the club will open with the main club house offer a restaurant , a bar, banquet facilities, kids facilities, swimming pool, gymnasium, ball games and a multi sports arena.

The later stages of the development will include tennis courts, outdoor BBQ areas, equestrian, open landscaped gardens and water sports facilities.

The Olympia Opaline development will house 2000 residential units. The development is located close to the IT corridor of Chennai and is designed to offer a 'walk to work' environment to its residents.





Ovolo Hotel, Aberdeen, Hong Kong

The Ovolo Hotels, managed by the Hind Properties Group, has appointed ILC to offer Preliminary Design Review Assistance for their new property in Aberdeen. The hotel is scheduled to open in the first quarter of 2013.

A pre existing industrial building is being retrofitted and being converted in to a 154 key business hotel. The hotel will be branded as ‘The Ovolo Hotel’ and would be Hind Group’s 5th hotel in Hong Kong.

Along with the rooms, the hotel will also have a restaurant, health club, lobby lounge and a roof top lounge on the 23rd floor.

The hotel is a part of the Hind Group promoted ‘Ovolo Hotels’ brand. Currently, Hong Kong has four Ovolo branded hotels and two Ovolo branded serviced apartments.

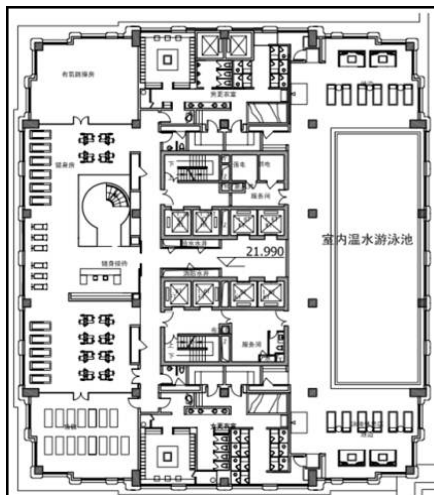
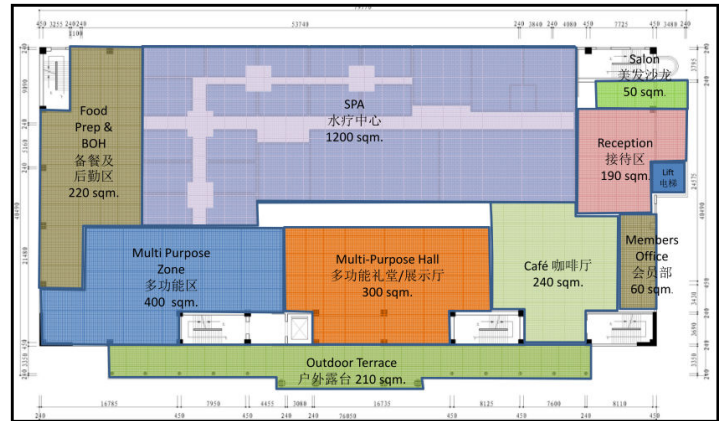
Shenyang, Le Meridien

Set in the city’s central business district, Le Meridien Shenyang, Heping is steps from corporate offices, restaurants, and shopping malls. Shenyang is one of the most important cities in Northern China. The hotel is scheduled to open in 2016 and it includes a 900 square meter spa and health club space, for which ILC are currently undertaking a feasibility study and will be providing development services.



Quanzhou Spa Club

The Quanzhou Spa Club is a spa oriented city club with a total floor area of 2700 square meter developed by a private client in Quanzhou. The city of Quanzhou is in the province of Fujian. The spa club will be consisting of spa, salon, café, event space as well as exercise facility. It is scheduled to open by the end of 2012. ILC are providing full pre opening services to establish the club.



Ningbo, Cixi Sheraton

Ningbo Cixi Sheraton is going to be the first international 5-star Hotel establishment in the city of Cixi, which is about one hour drive to the city of Ningbo. The hotel is scheduled to open in 2015 and includes a 1500 square meter. spa and health club space. ILC will be working with the owning company as well as Starwood on the development of these facilities.
